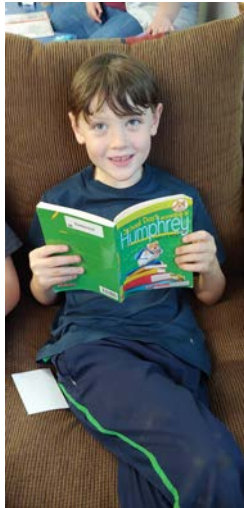


Lower Elementary News
