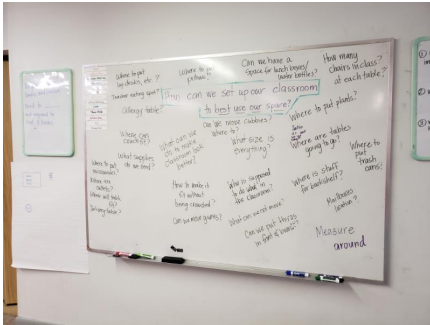


Upper Elementary News
